**A MEMO FROM ARCHBISHOP J. MICHAEL MILLER, CSB (initialed +JMM):** “The 2015 Lunar Year for Chinese, Vietnamese, Korean, Malaysian and other ethnic groups, coincides with Ash Wednesday. Therefore, I dispense, in accordance with Canon 87.1, those of the faithful who are present in the Archdiocese of Vancouver and those who are subjects of the Archdiocese of Vancouver, wherever they may be, who will celebrate the Lunar New Year on Ash Wednesday, February 18, 2015, the dispensation from the laws of abstinence and fasting.

However, as Lent is a penitential time of preparation for the liturgical celebration of the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Our Lord, Jesus Christ, I am obliging all who make use of this dispensation to observe a day of fast and abstinence on one other day at the beginning of Lent, such as Wednesday, February 25, 2015 or Friday, February 27, 2015.

The Mass and distribution of ashes takes place as usual on Ash Wednesday, February 18, 2015.

Please note that this relaxation of the rule for such a significant day in the Church's liturgical year is a one-time dispensation only and is *not valid* for future years.”
